THE SYMPOSIUM

ISP Africa was officially launched in Abuja Nigeria in May 24, 2024 and is the regional chapter for Africa in Nigeria. This two-day symposium will encompass:

Day 1 (12:00pm Onwards) – Crop, Milling and Processing:

There are technical presentations bringing expert both from foreign countries and locally that will share essential knowledge and skills to develop and implement sustainable commercially viable plantations.

Day 1 (7:30pm Onwards) – Ghana Gala dinner night (Traditional Attire).

Day 2 – (Morning) – Official Launch of the Symposium: Official speakers to mark the 1st Anniversary of ISP Africa and launch the ISP Ghana Branch.

Day 2 (1:00pm Onwards) – Investment pathways to building a sustainable commercial agriculture project:

This includes plenary presentation by opinion leaders to de-risk agriculture investment opportunities in order to attract either equity or debt financing for investments. Experts in the field of investments (equity or debt), insurance (capital, crop, political, currency, contractor and contract), plantation managers or operators and borrowers will provide insight to this area.

Background - ISP Africa is a professional body that aims to promote trade, investment, and economic cooperation between African countries and improve the Plantation Industry's environment. The Incorporated Society of Planters (ISP) headquartered in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, was founded in 1919 and is the parent body for the ISP Africa chapter.
